

Pleasure Horse Classes

These classes are judged on performance, condition and confirmation, however, a minimum of 20% of the judging shall be based on condition and confirmation of the horse/pony. Horses must be shown at a walk, jog and lope (except for the Walk & Jog Class) on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint.

All videos have to be taken from the letter "C" of a 20 x 40 or 20 x 60 m arena.

Walk & Jog Class

We decided to use dressage arena markers for our beginner test since most of us will probably use one of those for tests. On request, we are happy to send you an alternative version.

1. Start your test with a halt at "X" looking at "B"
2. Walk on, turn right at "B", and use the entire arena to show your walk
3. Jog at "A", once around the arena.
4. Walk at "A"
5. Reverse your horse at "B" (turn away from the rail) and show your walk
6. Jog at "C", once around the arena.
7. Walk at "C"
8. Turn left at "E" and finish your test with a halt at "X"

Novice Rider/Novice Horse Class

1. Be ready at A.
2. Walk to B.
3. At B, jog to D.
4. At D, lope on a left lead to G.
5. At G, walk and reverse (turn away from the rail).
6. At G, jog to D with a leg yield out to pass the two cones and leg yield to return to the track.
7. At D, lope on a right lead.
8. At B, stop and back up.
9. Hesitate to slow completion of pattern.
